

The central character of this documentary film is Nobuko Kikuchi, who lives in Iwanuma city in Miyagi Prefecture.

At the time of the Great East Japan Disaster, since Nobuko is deaf, she couldn't hear the tsunami warnings, but a neighbor came to tell Nobuko, using gestures, that a big tsunami was coming, and she was able to flee the area.

After that, the huge tsunami came and washed away her house. If that neighbor hadn't come to tell Nobuko about the tsunami, she and her husband would have been washed away and probably would have perished.

I spent a year filming Nobuko and the various problems she faced as a deaf person in the evacuation shelter and temporary housing.
